OVERVIEW

The Biblical Core Course, (previously called School of Biblical Studies Core Course) is a 12 week course that introduces students to the Inductive Approach of Biblical Study, equipping them with many tools for integrating the Word into their personal lives and using it as a foundation for everything they do.

The students are taught how to employ many diverse and creative methods for observing, interpreting and applying the Scriptures. Students will also have an opportunity to be involved in dramatic re-creations and an understanding of Biblical History.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND BCC?

Everyone who wants to grow in their understanding and knowledge of God and His Word!

The school will provide each student with an excellent introduction to Scripture and provide experienced teaching that is essential for Christian growth. The DTS is a prerequisite for this school. You will obtain 12 credits with the UofN.

WHAT WILL I STUDY?

As students you will observe what is in the text, learn to interpret it with the help of background information and be able to apply the word of God to your life. A week is spent on how to lead a small group Bible Study and one week on learning to preach and teach.

During the course students will read through the entire Bible and study in depth at least 14 books of the Bible. Students will become familiar with every form of literature in the Old and New Testaments. The Biblical Core Course provides a means for learning how to incorporate the Scriptures into areas of evangelism, prayer, worship and intercession. Students will learn how to memorise and meditate upon Scriptures. Students gain experience in inductive teaching and leading small groups and are equipped to give away what they have learned.

Although BCC is a complete, stand-alone course, it is designed to interface compatibly with the longer, nine month School of Biblical Studies. Should a student so desire, he or she may proceed on the second and third quarters of the SBS at another location.

COST

The cost of this school is \$4000 NZD, which includes tuition, food and board. Please check the current exchange rate on www.xe.com.

LOCATION

Oxford is a rural town of 2000 inhabitants situated fifty kilometres west of Christchurch, in the foothills of the Southern Alps of the South Island. The town itself has a range of retail and service amenities, including a post office, library, cafe, supermarket, etc. We are situated an hour away from scenery recognized in movies like Chronicles of Narnia and Lord of the Rings.



YWAM Oxford is comprised of several houses, offices, kitchen, and classrooms. The base is home to an average of thirty staff, and has a maximum capacity of seventy people.
